

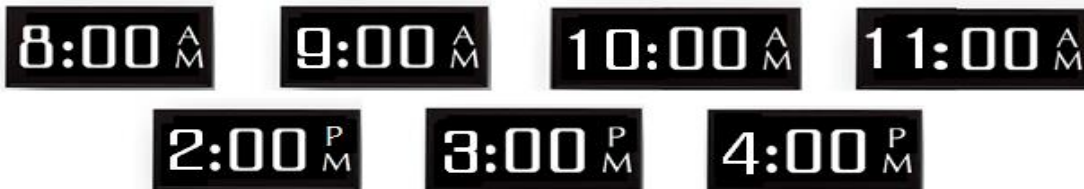
Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) Participants



In an effort to streamline our procedures, the Southern Nevada Regional Housing Authority (SNRHA) has begun a new policy regarding moving from one unit to another **within our jurisdiction.**

This new policy will go into effect Tuesday, September 10, 2019.

SNRHA's Contract Team will hold one-hour "Mover Sessions" every Tuesday and Thursday at:



Mover Sessions will be held on a 1st Come – 1st Serve Basis.

YOU MUST SIGN-IN AT THE FRONT DESK.

Restrictions on Elective Moves:

- ✓ HUD Regulations indicate SNRHA will deny a family permission to make an elective move during the family's initial lease term (the first 12 months of their lease.)
- ✓ We cannot issue a voucher and move packet if you are currently under eviction for serious violations of the lease.

Move Process:

Participants in SNRHA's HCV Program can transfer their assistance from one rental unit to another. There are three (3) steps to the move process:

1. "Intent to Vacate" Form (available online or in our lobby.)
 2. Issuing the Voucher (at the above mentioned sessions.)
 3. Submitting/Returning the completed "Request for Tenancy Approval" (RFTA) packet (*)
- ✓ You must serve a proper 30-day notice to the owner/landlord and provide SNRHA with a copy at the moving sessions listed above.
 - ✓ Once the voucher is issued, the family has 120 calendar days to look for a new unit starting from the day the voucher is issued (at the briefing.)

() Submitting the RFTA: No Appointment necessary. Drop the packet off at our front desk @ 380 N. Maryland Pkwy.*
