The Southern Nevada Regional Housing Authority (SNRHA) provides subsidized housing for low-income persons who meet both the Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) and SNRHA's admission criteria. Wait lists will be open and we will accept applications for the following programs:

- **Designated Housing for the Elderly - 0/1 Bedrooms** – Head, Spouse or Co-Head who are 55 years of age or older. **OPEN UNTIL JUNE 5, 2015**
- **Conventional Public Housing – 0/1, 2, 3, & 4 Bedrooms. OPEN UNTIL JUNE 5, 2015**
- **Landsman Gardens (Henderson) – 4 & 5 Bedrooms. OPEN UNTIL MAY 15, 2015**
- **Espinoza Terrace (Henderson) – 0/1 Bedrooms** – Head, Spouse or Co-Head must be 55 years of age or older. **OPEN UNTIL MAY 15, 2015.**

Preference points shall be assigned to all applications that meet the criteria for each preference. SNRHA provides preferences, which will be verified, for:

- Applicants who are employed 20 or more hours per week
Full time students in an accredited school or training program
Receiving SSI/SSD or other Income based on inability to work or 62 years of age or older
- Families that live or work within Clark County
- Veterans and Disabled Veterans (disability must be service connected)
- Spouse of a deceased veteran (death must be service connected)

Further explanation of preferences is printed on our preliminary application.

Applications are accepted Monday – Friday from 8am - 5pm (except holidays) at, SHRHA's Admissions Department located at 5390 East Flamingo Rd., Las Vegas, Nevada 89122.
