Income Limits for this Waiting List are based on the Households Gross Annual Income as follows:

Preference points shall be assigned to all applications that meet the criteria for each preference. SNRHA provides preferences, which will be verified, for:

- Applicants who are employed 20 or more hours per week
Full time students in an accredited school or training program
Receiving SSI/SSD or other Income based on inability to work or 62 years of age or older
- Families that live or work within Clark County
- Veterans and Disabled Veterans (disability must be service connected)
- Spouse of a deceased veteran (death must be service connected)

Further explanation of preferences is printed on our preliminary application.

Applications are accepted Monday – Friday from 8am - 5pm (except holidays and furlough Fridays) at, SHRHA’s Admissions Department located at 5390 East Flamingo Rd., Las Vegas, Nevada 89122.
