WHAT IS THE SECTION 3 PROGRAM?

Section 3 is a provision of the Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Act of 1968. Section 3 is to ensure that employment and other economic opportunities generated by certain HUD financial assistance shall, be directed to low- and very low-income persons, particularly those who are recipients of government assistance for housing, and to businesses which provide economic opportunities to low- and very low-income persons.



SECTION 3 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- **★** Public Housing resident.
- ★ Housing Choice Voucher participant (Section 8).
- ★ Income falls below HUD's income limits.



SECTION 3 PROJECTS INCLUDE

- ★ GENERAL CONSTRUCTION,
 DEMOLITION AND SITE CLEAN-UP
- ★ GROUNDSKEEPERS/LANDSCAPERS
- ★ CLERICAL/ADMINISTRATIVE

WHAT IS A SECTION 3 BUSINESS?

A Section 3 business is defined as one that:

- Is owned by Section 3 residents;
- Employs Section 3 residents; or,
- Subcontracts with businesses that provide opportunities to low-and very-low income persons.
