RE: SNRHA SECTION 3 REPORTING REQUIREMENT

Southern Nevada Regional Housing Authority (SNRHA) has an obligation to provide employment and contracting opportunities to eligible residents in the community who meet the income guidelines established by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). This Section 3 mandate can be found in 24 Code of Federal Regulations Part 135, Economic Opportunities for Low- and Very Low - Income Persons.

In an effort to ensure full internal compliance with the HUD mandates, SNRHA is seeking to identify applicants/employees who qualify as a Section 3 employee. A Section 3 employee is anyone whose household income, during FY 2018, falls at or below the area median income for the family size.

Special Notice: Completion of this form will not affect your employment status with SNRHA.
